


CITY OF TORRINGTON

Inland Wetland Commission SPECIAL MEETING - SITE WALK May 12, 2012

1. SITE WALK: A Special meeting was held at Mountain Top Trucking property on Winsted Road, Assessor's MBL 242/003/001 on Saturday, May 12, 2012 at 9:00. The walk began at ~9:10am.
2. ATTENDANCE: In attendance were Jay Bate – IWC Chairman, Christine Altman – IWC Vice-Chair, Kathy Carlson, Doris Murphy, Tom Telman, Jane Bakker, Nicole Bastiannse-Fritch, Kim Barbier – staff, Jerry Sanchy attorney, and Daniel Stoughton – Owner.
3. MINUTES:
 - a. Staff Kim Barbieri started off the meeting reviewing the 'silent site walk' requirements and explained why this is necessary. She explained she had a camera available to photograph any area of the site in which any commission member wanted to remember or to bring up at the regular meeting on Tuesday.
 - b. Attorney Sanchy started the site walk by showing the commission members a 100' tape he placed from the water's edge showing the haul road at that location at 100 feet.
 - c. Attorney Sanchy then walked the commission to the west around the pond to the area the inland wetlands agent alleges was excavated without permits. He explained that he had found a map that he plans to produce at the meeting on Tuesday that shows a pipe in the area of the alleged excavation. He then pointed out the pipe which was passing water. IWC Member Jane Bakker asked if the cleared area around the pond in which they were walking was new. Attorney Sanchy explained there had always been an accessway around the pond and it could be seen on the maps.
 - d. The Commission then walked back to the starting point. Staff person Kim Barbieri requested the commission to be allowed to review the entire area of violation including all of the north side of the pond and part of the east side of the pond along the haul road. Attorney Sanchy agreed after stating he didn't think it was proper because he felt it was outside the area of the violation.
 - e. The commission finished their walk and left the site at ~9:40am.
