Minutes of Special Meeting

Monday, November 9, 2009

Chairperson Patricia Fairchild called to order a special meeting of the Parks and Recreation Commission on Monday, November 9, 2009, at 5:00 P.M. at the Armory. In attendance were Vice –Chairman Fran Ducotey, Secretary Dan Lovallo, Commissioners Duke Wall and Jim Pescatore, Superintendent of Parks and Recreation Brett Simmons, and Recreation Director Donna Winn.

The purpose of the meeting was to formulate a survey which would be agreed to by all Commissioners. Commissioners voiced their opinions on the usage of the different types of bats, softballs, and issues related to the two. All opinions voiced suggested that safety is the reason for any changes made. The general consensus among Commissioners was to discontinue the use of the double-wall composite bat.

Superintendent Simmons devised some wording for the survey that met with favor among all the Commissioners. On a motion by Jim Pescatore with a second by Fran Ducotey, the Commission voted unanimously to accept the survey as formulated by Superintendent Simmons. This survey will be sent out to the team managers.
