

TORRINGTON PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION
SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES
June 10, 2009

Chairperson Pat Fairchild called to order a Special Meeting of the Torrington Parks and Recreation Commission at the Armory at 5:15 P.M.

In attendance were Chairperson Fairchild, Co-Chairperson Fran Ducotey, Secretary Dan Lovallo, Commissioner Jim Pescatore, Superintendent Brett Simmons, and Recreation Director Donna Winn.

Absent was Commissioner Duke Wall.

The purpose of the meeting was to cut \$25,624.00 from the 2009-2010 budget.

Brett informed the Commission that the City would be going forward with the fireworks, and will be asking for donations to help fund the event. A letter has been sent to local businesses explaining the different levels of pledges.

Giordano Signs will be donating a sign to recognize the pledges.

After a lengthy discussion, the Commission decided to make the cuts as follows, pending the financial outcome of the fireworks sponsorship initiative:

\$12,625.00 from League Stipends
\$8,500.00 from Custodial Fees for Varsity Alumni Basketball
\$1,800.00 from Community Programs
\$3,000.00 from Parks Electricity

A motion was made by Commissioner Pescatore and seconded by Commissioner Ducotey. All were in favor to approve the cuts as stated.

A motion to adjourn was made by Commissioner Pescatore and seconded by Commissioner Lovallo. All were in favor to adjourn at 5:55 P.M.
