

Torrington Historic Properties Commission  
Meeting Minutes for 3-5-20

The meeting was called to order at 6:10 pm in city hall room 215.  
Present were Travis Lipinski, Mark McEachern, Michael Bow, Marc Trivella,  
Ed Cannata, and Maggie Dwan.

The approval of minutes from the previous meeting was tabled.

A discussion took place regarding possible grant funded projects to recommend to the city once Torrington is approved as a Certified Local Government.

It was noted that funding was available to create a computer index for surveyed historic properties.

Mark McEachern mentioned that there are 5 or 6 completed historic resource surveys for various sections of Torrington. At one time, copies of several of these surveys were located at city hall.

The committee agreed that someone should try to locate the historic resource surveys at city hall. Any missing surveys could be duplicated from those at the Torrington Historical Society.

If the surveys on file with the State Historic Preservation Office are not yet scanned, then it was suggested that a project to scan Torrington's Historic Resource Surveys might be a good idea.

It was also suggested that we should investigate indexing the surveys.
